<b>Human Library Event in Bologna, Italy</b>	
<p>On February 28, 2024, YouNet hosted Human Library event at ITCS Salvemini High School in Bologna. The event brought to life the personal stories of extraordinary individuals, our "Human Books," who shared their experiences directly with the students, allowing them to engage with these stories intimately and closely.</p> <p>Among the Human Books who participated in this event, we had the privilege of hearing the experiences of members of ANPI Bologna (the National Association of the Italian Partisans). Each of them shared their life journeys and learnings, providing students with a unique and valuable perspective on various human experiences, with the focus on resistance of women in the conflicts of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. From stories of personal overcoming to tales of fighting for equality and social justice, each Human Book offered an authentic and enriching insight through their own words. The event gathered 47 participants, creating a powerful platform for intergenerational dialogue and understanding.

**Urban Trekking Events in Bologna, Italy**

On May 7, 2024, the WORTH Urban Trekking was organized through the streets of Bologna to uncover stories of courage and resistance of Italian women during the II World War. The event was hosted by YouNet in collaboration with the Technical Commercial Institute Rosa Luxemburg, and in gathered 38 participants, providing an opportunity to connect with the past and honor the remarkable contributions of women in the struggle for freedom and justice in Bologna.

Urban trek followed from the Monumento Ossario ai Caduti Partigiani to Via Irma Bandiera and the Memoriale alle Donne Cadute per la Resistenza, exploring monuments rich in history and heroism.

A highlight of the event was a narration by a member of ANPI Bologna (the National Association of the Italian Partisans), who shared the inspiring story of Adelia Casari, known as "Emma," who fought for labor rights and contributed to the Villa Spada monument in honor of fallen fighters (Monumento alle Cadute partigiane). This monument, built in 1975, is dedicated to the 128 partisan women from Bologna who fell during the liberation struggle. Located inside Villa Spada Park, it features a two-meter wall with bricks bearing the names of fallen partisans, decorated by students to ensure the memory of the Resistance is continually renewed.

The organized event was particularly engaging for the students, as it allowed them to learn about history in a unique and immersive way. By exploring significant locations in their city and uncovering the stories connected to women in resistance, the students gained a deeper understanding of the courageous efforts of those who fought against fascism and for the liberty of their country.

Following the events, all participants were promptly provided with essential project data and a link to access the EUSurvey platform.
